Of the 55 million abortions since 1972, 92% were done for social or financial reasons; we all need to be part of the solution to these social and financial problems that would drive a woman to take the life of her unborn child. One way we can be part of the solution is to participate in the March for Life –to meet with our legislators and to show the media that we care about both the mother and the baby.
